Biking For Babies

Hello! my name is Jessica Kantra and I am a missionary with an organization called Biking for Babies. As a missionary with them, I seek to promote a culture of life by riding my bike over 600 miles in one week. This year, over 80 missionaries will be riding on one of eight different routes, finishing in either St. Louis, MO or Washington DC. As for myself, I will be leading a team from Columbus, OH to our Nation's Capital.



As we train & ride, we strive to raise awareness for pregnancy resource centers

(PRCS). PRCs are places where women experiencing unplanned or crisis pregnancies can go to find support, free medical care (such as ultra sounds/checkups), supplies, counseling and more. Some PRCs even continue to work with these women for up to 3 years following the birth of their child in an effort to help them transition into life with a child with as little stress as possible.

Part of my job & the mission of Biking for Babies is to fundraise for our specific PRC so that they can continue providing women with extraordinary care, enabling them to feel confident choosing life over death.

The PRC I am paired with is Hand of Hope right here here in Raleigh. My goal is to raise \$2500 for them - last year I raised a little under \$4000, and I would love to surpass that total this year.

The Brown Scapular

Brown Scapular Enrollment

Friday July 14, 2023, at 4:00 PM. Msgr. Ingham will enroll anyone who has not been previously enrolled. The enrollment will take place after Benediction.

Brown scapulars will be provided for anyone who would like to be enrolled as well as information about the benefits of being enrolled in the Confraternity.

What is a Brown Scapular Enrollment?

What is the Spiritual **Benefit?**

The Brown Scapular enrollment is a spiritual enrollment, placing yourself under the protection and guidance of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. The symbol of the two small pieces of wool that is worn in the front and the back comes from the habit worn by the Carmelites. For those professed in the Carmelite order, the scapular is a brown wool apron that hangs over the front and back of the habit. For laity it is the two small square pieces of wool that is worn around the neck, in front and in back.

Sometimes it is helpful to describe what something is, by telling you what it is not. It is not a good luck charm that you wear to bring you good fortune. It does not mean that you will go to heaven just because you placed the Scapular around your neck and forgo trying to live a holy life.

It is a Sacramental that shows your devotion to Mary and desire for her protection. Some who wear the scapular are members of the Lay order of Carmelites; they pray the Divine Office every day along with the rosary or the Little Office of Our Lady. Others have barely enough time to say the Hail Mary. But all should have a devotion to Our Lady, a daily prayer life, and seriously try to live the teachings of the Catholic Church centered on our Eucharistic Lord. Our Lady will honor this spiritual enrollment and grant you the benefits that are attached to the Brown Scapular.

The promise given by Our Lady is that those who die wearing the Brown Scapular will not suffer eternal damnation. This Promise was given to St. Simon Stock in the 13th century when Our Lady appeared to him. It was officially recognized by the Church and aranted to all those in the Carmelite Order.


